	DECLARATION OF RON SHICKLES IN SUPPORT OF DEPENDANT STATE OF CALIFORNIA'S OPPOSITION TO PLAINTIPPS. MOTION FOR SUPPLANT ADJUDICATION	•

 If called to testify in the above-captioned matter, I could and would testify competently to the following facts that are within my own personal knowledge.

2. I am the principal of Jurupa Valley High School in Mira Loma, California. I have been principal of Jurupa Valley for two years. Prior to that, I worked as the Co-Principal of John Burroughs High School in the Eurbank Unified School District and as a English and Drama teacher.

- 3. I have extensive knowledge of the students, teachers, and facilities at Jurupa Valley High School, and am familiar with the curriculum and instructional materials that are provided to Jurupa Valley Students. I know the Spanish teacher, Carlos Moreno, who teaches at Jurupa Valley High and have read his declaration concerning the instructional materials and other conditions at this school.
 - 4. Carlos Moreno alleges that the textbooks in his Spanish II class were over 15 years old and in poor condition and that he lacked supplemental materials with which to teach his students. I have examined the Spanish II texts to which he refers and they are in adequate condition and could be read by the students. Moreover, the Spanish Department at Jurupa Valley has ordered new

Spanish II textbooks and accompanying supplemental materials, and they will arrive this summer and be available for students in the 2003-2004 school year. As acknowledged by Mr. Moreno in his declaration, Jurupa Valley High has already obtained new textbooks and supplemental learning materials for its Spanish I classes in the past year.

- Valley High resulted in "traveling teachers" because there were not enough classrooms for all the teachers. However, portable classrooms were added before fall of 2002 and for the past year, there have been no "traveling teachers" at Jurupa Valley High. With the addition of these portable classrooms, there is no overcrowding at this school. In fact, Jurupa Valley High has a campus of 55 acres for approximately 2,800 students.
 - language department at Jurupa Valley High does not have a high turnover rate due to the conditions at the school. The teachers who have left the foreign language department in the past few years have either retired, moved for family reasons or returned to teaching at the elementary school level. No teachers have ever informed me that they were leaving the school because of the lack of classrooms or any other condition at Jurupa Valley High.
 - 7. The bathrooms at Jurupa Valley High are monitored more than once daily by either quidance counselors, administrators or campus supervisors who are assigned to supervise them. They

report immediately any problems they notice such as broken stall doors, toilers and ginks or graffiti and these problems are addressed immediately. The custodial staff cleans the bathrooms daily and an undercover agent from the sherriff's department was engaged to apprehend students who graffiti the bathrooms. administration at Jurupa Valley High makes every effort to keep their bathrooms clean and safe. I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this 30th day of July, 2003 at Mira Loma. California. Shecklen
