

1 to use the bathroom, someone would see you because there is no door.


2 7. Sometimes the bathrooms at school are so nasty people cut school just to go home

14 too cold. When it's too hot, we can't open our windows because they don't open. If it's hot, you
15 have to fan yourself with a lot of paper. When it's cold, we stand at the heater with our coats on.
16 We're supposed to wear uniforms, though, and so sometimes the teachers don't let us wear our coats
17 in class because coats aren't part of the uniform. In February and the beginning of March when it
18 was raining a lot, it was really cold and mice started coming out in the classrooms. I wore two
19 sweaters, some gloves, some earmuffs, and a scarf in class. I feel sick when it's too hot or too cold
20 at school.

21 10. The ceiling tiles fall off in the gym if you shoot a basketball too high. We all have
22 to dodge to avoid being hit by the ceiling tiles.
