
2 10. My husband and I find it necessary to supplement our children's education. Our son,

12 a suitable environment. During the week of the Stanford 9 exam, concerned parents of the PTA
13 arrived at school as early as 4:30 a.m. to prepare a hot breakfast for the entire student body (made
14 possible by monetary contributions of the parents and local businesses). The breakfast consisted of
15 pancakes, sausage, bacon, eggs, juice and milk. We are simply trying to do more with the few
16 resources available to better serve the children.
