- I, Kip Falepouono, hereby declare:
- 1. I make this declaration based on my own personal knowledge and if called to testify I could and would do so competently as follows:
- 2. My son Gilbert Falepouono attended Costaño Elementary School in East Palo Alto from kindergarten until fifth grade. He just graduated from the school in June of 2001.
- 3. During Gilbert's fourth grade year he had substitutes for several months, and he had two different teachers. I was concerned about this, because I was worried he would not get the same education with so many different teachers in his classroom. I never complained to the administrators, because I did not know what to do to make the situation better for my son. During kindergarten Gilbert also had different substitutes for a few months, and I don't know why. It seems like teachers leave the school often.
- 4. I also rarely saw my son bring home any books from school during all of his years at the elementary school. When I asked my son why he did not bring home any books, he told we that in some of his subjects he was not allowed to bring home his books because there weren't enough.
