

1 6. We only have three bathrooms total at Hosler. One is only for the sixth graders to
2 use. During breaks an aide stands outside the sixth grade bathroom and won't let any seventh and
3 eighth grade students inside. The administrators also tell the seventh and eighth grade students
4 that they are not allowed to use that bathroom. One is locked all the time, and the other one is for
5 all of the seventh and eighth grade students. In the girls seventh and eighth grade bathroom there
6 are only three stalls. During lunch time there is usually a long, long line to use the bathroom
7 because there are just not enough stalls for all of the students. At least twice this past year I was
8 waiting in line and the bell rang before I could go to the bathroom and so I had to go to class. A
9 lot of times the sinks are flooded in the bathroom also. During lunch time there is an aide who
10 watches the bathrooms and makes sure they don't get too dirty, but during the rest of the day
11 because students are using the bathrooms a lot they can get really smelly and gross. If I don't go
12 to the bathroom during lunch I will usually hold it all day because the bathrooms get really gross.

13 7. In my sixth grade year during the 1999-2000 school year we were not allowed to
14 bring our English textbooks home with us because there were not enough books. It affects my
15 learning when I cannot bring my textbooks home with me because I have to do everything in a
16 hurry so that I can finish my assignment before the end of the period. Also, I when I can't bring
17 my textbook home with me it is hard to study for tests and to review the materials that we went
18 over in class. In my health class we only had a class set of textbooks, and so we couldn't take
19 our textbook home with us. Also, these books were all ripped up and had drawings all over
20 them. About ten different times during the school year I would turn to a page and it would be
21 ripped up or there would be writing all over the page, and I wasn't able to read the assignment or
22 the exercise that was assigned by the teacher. When this happened I would share with a friend or
23 look at their book, but that took extra time and it was difficult to follow along.


