I, Joe Gamble, hereby declare:

- 1. I make this declaration based on my own personal knowledge and if called to testify I could and would do so competently as follows:
- 2. I am an Area Representative for United Teachers of Los Angeles for District I, which includes Locke High School.
- 3. I visited Locke High School for one day at the end of November, 2000, to meet with a math teacher whose classroom had been displaced for undisclosed reasons. I encountered the displaced teacher walking through the halls with his students. The students and teacher finally located a class to use that was next to the computer lab. They had to wait several minutes until someone with a key came up to let them in the classroom.
- 4. I found the conditions at Locke appalling. I observed trash in the hallways and classroom floors that were unkept and dirty.
- 5. During my visit to Locke in November, 2000, I visited the computer lab. The lab had no air conditioning and it was very hot. The computers had been on for probably five hours at that point and added to the heat in the room. I estimated that it was probably eighty-five to ninety degrees in the lab. The students in the lab were visibly sweating, as was the teacher. The displaced math teacher assisted the teacher in the lab in turning on the two old, industrial size fans in the room, but they had no effect on the temperature.

I declare under penalty of perjury of the laws of the State of California and the United States that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this \(\frac{1}{2} \) day of \(\frac{5eptember}{2001} \) in Los Angeles, California.
