DECLARATION OF JOHN ROMO

- 1. I am 17 years old and in the 12th grade at Watsonville High School located in Watsonville, California. I have attended this school since 9th grade. I make this declaration based on my own personal knowledge and if called to testify I could and would do so competently as follows:
- 2. A problem at my high school has been textbooks. For instance, last year the books we used in my History, Algebra, and Trigonometry classes were very old and outdated. The United States History textbook, for instance, only covered up until 1992 when Bill Clinton began his presidency. This book also had graffiti on it. In my United States History class we were not given our own book to take home for homework, rather we had to check one out if we wanted to use it overnight.
